Qualifications for Petitioners

Any Master Mason in good standing in a Blue Lodge, also a legal resident of Vermont for one year and in the Jurisdiction of this Valley for six months (it matters not where his Blue Lodge is located) is eligible to apply.

Candidate fees for the degrees of this Valley are \$70.00 and include the first year's dues.

Vermont Consistory candidate fees are \$55.00 paid to the Valley of Burlington in which the Body of the Vermont Consistory resides.

Yearly dues of the Valley of Central VT are \$56.00, which includes the per capita of the Supreme Council. Yearly dues for the Consistory of the Valley of Burlington are \$14.00.
